Upon finding this site the first thing that caught my eye and made me stop to look at it was the great art that decorated the page. The page was colorful and looked very professional. Appearance is important in attracting viewers to your site.

The main page provides a short introduction to medieval times and to what the site is going to provide for the viewer. Docked on the left, a long list of table of contents to chose from, including life, history, famines, food, health, literature, chivalry, and romance. Each link had many sub links to chose from, each providing an informative and easy to read summary. In reviewing the literature link, the sub links included monks, troubadours, early works, masterpieces, and printing. Each of these sub links described what the works were, what they were about and who wrote them.
